SLEEPING INDIAN FOALS PROVE POPULAR

Sleeping Indian's first foals provided some bright lights during difficult economic market conditions at Goffs and Tattersalls Breeding Stock Sales.

At Tattersalls Trickle-down Stud's colt out of Hidden Meaning, realised 52,000 Gns (Lot 988). He was purchased by agent Geoffrey Howson for shrewd pin-hooker Paddy Twomey of Hawthorn Villa Stud, who said: "I bought two foals by Sleeping Indian and both are exceptional, probably the nicest stock by a first season stallion. They should make very impressive yearlings."

Sleeping Indian's foals also had plenty of admirers at Goffs with an attractive colt out of a Stakes-placed daughter of Moscow Ballet from The Castlebridge Consignment making €26,000 (Lot 404). Purchaser Jimmy Murphy of Redpender Stud commented: "I was delighted to get him, he's a really grand foal and a lovely, free mover. I thought there's a lot of Indian Ridge in him too."

THE NEXT HELLYELYN

A cracking colt foal by Ishiguru realised 27,000 Gns at the Tattersalls December Foal Sale. Not dissimilar in many ways to Coventry winner Hellyelyn from Ishiguru's exceptional first crop, he is certainly one to watch in the future.

Purchased by Luke Lillingston for owner Richard Pegum, the weanling is out of the dam of Gr.2 Queen Mary 4th Sparkling Eyes.

Lillingston was thrilled with the colt and said of Ishiguru: "I doubt there will be better value anywhere. He is a much better stallion than many horses standing for far more. Every breeder should have Ishiguru on their radar."

It was not all doom and gloom at the Tattersalls December Sales, as more Tweenhills' stars illustrate.

The Stakes placed filly Shivering bought by David Redvers from Tattersalls July Sale 2008 for 35,000 Gns made a quick profit realising 58,000 Gns this time round. Purchased by John Warren for Newsells Park Stud, she was owned by 'Bloodstock Trading and Investments', an EIS syndicate run at Tweenhills.

The three-time winner and consistently placed filly, Swift Princess, part-owned by Tweenhills Racing sold to John Bromley Bloodstock for 30,000 Gns. She had originally been purchased for 21,000 Gns as a yearling.
