Hartley won his maiden by a remarkable 7l at Catterick in September, for trainer James Bethell and owners Clarendon Thoroughbred Racing. Rated 93p by Timeform, he will now be targeting Stakes races.

This success for Lucky Story was soon followed up by a winning double on 29th September. Super Fourteen won his maiden at Brighton and Sequillo landed the nursery at Windsor for master two-year-old trainer Richard Hannon.

At the time of press Lucky Story ranks in the top 5 first season sires by prize money won and winners to runners. This sire of leading two-year-old Art Connoisseur stays at Tweenhills Farm & Stud in 2009.

The two-year-old filly, Pasar Silbano, landed her fourth win of the season when comfortably taking the Goffs Sportsman's Challenge over 6f at the Curragh. A very consistent filly from day one, she was following up her success in the 5f Curragh Stakes (L). Her next target will be the Moccasin Stakes at Hollywood Park, USA.

By Elnadim she was a real bargain having been purchased by David Redvers with trainer Ger Lyons for just €25,000 from the Goffs Sportsman Sale. She has now won her connections nearly £100,000 in prize money.

## SUCCESS FOR TWEENHILLS RACING

The Tweenhills Racing two-year-old, Ursula, recently won her maiden at Haydock over 5f with plenty up her sleeve despite running a bit green on only her second appearance.

A half sister to May Hill Stakes (Gr.2) third Sans Reward by Namid, she looks an exciting prospect next year for Tweenhills Racing and trainer Karl Burke. She was purchased by David Redvers for 24,000gns from the Tattersalls Guineas Breeze-Up Sale.

## REDVERS RANT

Am I the only one to believe that the Sales Million races have run their course?

I can understand the attraction in boom times when the costs incurred in training and entering horses for these races are outweighed by the chance of a big prize – but now?

If Tattersalls want to keep the middle and lower market alive during a recession, what better way than put on a 40 race maiden series with £20k to the winner for any horse sold through the October Sales qualifying for two £400k finals.

Agents and trainers then have a major incentive for owners – the chance to pay for your year's training bill on winning a Tattersalls maiden plus two big prizes, and that leaves £300k to give to BBM to market the Sale abroad.
