2YO LISTED WINNER

The two-year-old filly, Pasar Silbano, gained a well deserved third win of the season when landing the 5f Curragh Stakes (L) at the Phoenix Stakes Meeting, having previously been Stakes placed twice.

This Elnadim filly is proving a real bargain as she was purchased by David Redvers for just €25,000 from the Goffs Sportsman Sale with trainer Ger Lyons, who was enjoying a Listed race double at the Curragh that day.

Clearly delighted, Ger said of Pasar Silbano's performance: "That was grand. She is still green and inexperienced, and will be an even better three-year-old."

Ger Lyons is just one of several trainers David will be busy helping at the forthcoming yearling sales. Others include Jamie Osborne, the in-form Ralph Beckett, and Peter Winkworth who enjoyed a double celebration on 8th August with two juveniles purchased by David.
